Too many boys and girls go without a bed—or even a pillow—to sleep on. These children end up sleeping on couches, blankets, and even floors. Bedlessness affects children's happiness and health. A bed provides proper physical, emotional and mental support every child needs.

Sleep in Heavenly Peace® is a non-profit group of volunteers dedicated to building, assembling and delivering top-notch bunk beds to children and families in need so no child sleeps on the floor.

Wildare is hosting a Build Day on September 11, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Join us to find out how you can help: April 8 at 6:30 in the church connector.

Each bunk bed costs \$400. (wood, hardware, mattress, bedding, comforters, pillows, mattress covers) The SHP Team provide all the tools and safety equipment on build day.


There are many other opportunities to participate and support this project:

Monetary tax deductible donations. Assist in delivering beds to local families. Participate in a fundraiser.


