Pastor's Front Page Message

Lent 2023 is here! Special thanks to Pastor Gary Frost for being our guest minister at our Ash Wednesday service. I was not sure how the after care for my son would go since his surgery so I tried to plan ahead and called Pastor Frost to help if needed. He was needed. So once again thanks to him and of course all others who helped with, participated, came out or joined us online. Scott Hughes, an Elder in the UMC states that, "Lent is, after all, as he notes, a move from "penance to penitence to repentance." He continues by stating that, "Lent offers us a season of intentional spiritual practices (giving something up, being more disciplined with spiritual disciplines, etc.) that places us in a position for the Holy Spirit to reveal areas of idolatry as well as provide fertile ground for growth in the fruit of the Spirit." The Holy Spirit is indeed working in our world and we are grateful for that!

Experiencing God by Henry & Richard Blackaby and Claude King is a series that many have studied and put into practice. I believe at one time, this series was taught here at Wildare UMC. A writer from mintools.com states that, "... the one idea that keeps coming back to me the most is: "Watch to see where God is working and join Him." Blackaby and King used John 5:17, 19-20 as the Scriptural basis for this concept. The idea is that because God is always working, we just have to discern where and join Him. In his defense Jesus said to them, "My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working." (Jn. 5:17) Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. For the Father loves the Son and shows him all he does. Yes, and he will show him even greater works than these, so that you will be amazed." (Jn. 5:19-20)

Well, depending upon who you are listening to, etc.....God seems to be working visibly in the world at Asbury University with a spiritual awakening revival this past month or so and with a new movie coming out entitled, *Jesus Revolution*. The powerful true story of how revival, rock and roll, and young hippies on fire for Jesus changed the course of America in the 1960s and 1970s is hitting theaters in February. The "Jesus Revolution" film tells the story of a young Greg Laurie who is searching for truth in all the wrong places until he meets a hippie street preacher named Lonnie Frisbee, played by "The Chosen's" Jonathan Roumie. Together, they, along with Pastor Chuck Smith played by Kelsey Grammer, open the doors of a Southern California church to an unexpected revival and a newfound love for Jesus that leads to a spiritual awakening.

As we move into Lent, let us see how we can join and/or continue to join God in His work in the world. Here are some questions for reflection from Rev. Hughes. **Reflection Questions:** As a disciple of Jesus Christ, what are some simple steps you can take to be open to the Holy Spirit's movement in your life? How are young people currently being formed in their faith in your church? How do you think they would react if they found themselves in a revival? How might spiritual practices (routine chapel services, prayer, Bible study, etc.) set the table and increase the odds for a revival like this to happen? What spiritual practices might you partake in this coming Lent to prepare you for a fresh experience of God's love shed abroad in your life? Have a blessed month! March is also Women's History Month.
